## **ORDER**

KESBL as per Board Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> Paper above accorded sanction to conduct pre- feasibility study for the establishment of a second Power House with 780 MW by a Technical Committee from within the Organisation and to submit a report within a period of one month. It was also decided to approach the Government with pre- feasibility study report for permission for inviting Global tender for conducting a feasibility study including preparation of Detailed Project Report.

Later, based on the recommendation of the Chief Engineer ( C-I&CC), the Board vide Order read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above had accorded sanction to the Chief Engineer (C-I&CC) to follow the Quality Cost Based Selection Process (QCBS) for identification of successful bidders for preparation of PFR/DPR of Idukki Hydro Electric Project – Exploring the possibility of tapping the available potential with 75% weightage for Technical Component and 25% weightage for Financial Component with the objective of getting more participation. Based on the above,the Chief Engineer (C-I&CC) had floated Tender ID: 2019\_KSEB\_273172\_1 for the Request for Proposal document vide e- tendering System portal of Government of Kerala on 05.03.2019.

Later the Chief Engineer (C-I&CC) vide letter dated 28.3.2019 reported that, the tender invited had not been on Global basis. It is also reported that the proposal is envisaged in close proximity to Idukki Wild Life Sanctuary, as well as the existing installations of KSEBL is identified as a sensitive location. Hence KSEBL is bound to comply with the relevant provisions of Office Memorandum No: 7/1/2002-DO (NHPC) (Vol.II) dated 03.09.2009 issued by the Ministry of Power, Government of India "Guidelines for participation of foreign companies in tenders of work packages of Hydroelectric Projects in sensitive areas". The RFP floated does not

bar foreign firms from participating in the process now initiated by KSEBL and considering the above, the Chief Engineer (I&CC) had sought sanction to cancel the tender process initiated by him.

Based on the note read 7<sup>th</sup> above, the CMD -KSEBL had accorded sanction for the cancellation of the tender and the above decision was communicated vide Office Order read as 8<sup>th</sup> paper above. It was also ordered to place the matter before FTD for ex-post facto sanction.

Accordingly, the matter was placed before the Full Time Directors vide note read as 9<sup>th</sup> above. Having considered the matter in detail, the FTD in the meeting held on 04.4.2019 resolved to accord ex-post facto sanction for cancellation of the tender process initiated by the Chief Engineer (C-I&CC) for the selection of suitable consultant for identification of a viable proposal to tap the potential available at the existing Idukki Hydro Electric Project leading to the preparation of PFR/DPR.

Further resolved to approach the Government for obtaining permission as decided by the Director Board.

Further resolved to appraise the Government and the Director Board regarding the matter of going for tender for preparation of DPR from Service Providers / Agencies within India instead of Global tender considering the fact that the Idukki dam area is covered under the Official Secrets Act, 1923.

Orders are issued accordingly.


