ORDER

The Chief Engineer (Generation & PED), as per letter read above reported about the massive land slide occurred at 16:45 hrs. on 09-08-2019, at the rear side of KES and KAES building of KHEP and the status of restoration works. All the floors of KAES, KES and the service bay were filled with debris mud, boulders, rocks, logs etc. which resulted in the total shutdown of the stations (150 MW). As the calamity had affected the Power Generation from the stations, urgent restoration works were planned and executed urgently with the available manpower (staff & contract workers- approximately 75 nos.) in the station.

It is reported that the staff & contract workers at the station having enough experience and knowledge about the station and equipment were engaged for the execution of cleaning and restoration works by observing all the safety aspects. As the nature of the work demands continuous execution and considering the advantage of utilising the available manpower without wasting time, envisaged for the speedy restoration of the stations, daily meals including breakfast, lunch and evening tea has been arranged departmentally, by preparing the same at the power house premises itself. The above arrangement saved a lot of time and money which would have been elapsed, if the food is arranged from outside.

In the above circumstances, sanction was requested for an estimate amounting to Rs.1,91,250/- which has been prepared by considering the daily rate of Rs.85/-per day per person, for the food expenses in connection with the urgent restoration works of Unit #4,5&6. The rates were arrived as per the observed expenses incurred locally for a total 30 days of work.

Having considered the recommendation in the Note read as 2nd paper above, the Full Time Directors meeting held on 30-08-2019 resolved to accord sanction to an estimate amounting to Rs.1,91,250/- (Rupees One Lakh Ninety One Thousand Two Hundred & Fifty only), for arranging daily meals including breakfast, lunch and evening tea for the staff and contract workers under K.G.Division, Kakkayam in connection with the urgent restoration works of Unit #4,5 &6.

Orders are issued accordingly.
