CIRCULAR

Sub: Tariff revision effective from 08.07.2019 – Conditions for allowing concessional tariff to Cancer patients and permanently disabled persons –instructions- reg.

Read: 1. KSERC order on 08.07.2019 in the petition filed by KSEB Ltd. for the approval of ARR, ERC and tariff proposal for the control period 2018-19 to 2021-22.

2. B.O. (FTD) No.5312019 (KSEBL/TRAC/Tariff Revision/2018-19) dated 10. 07. 2019

1. Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (KSERC) vide order read above has revised the retail tariff applicable to all categories of consumers and Bulk supply tariff (BST) of Licensees w.e.f. 08.07.2019. KSEB Ltd. vide board order under reference, has ordered to implement the revised tariff for all categories of consumers w.e.f. 08.07.2019..

2. Hon'ble Commission has allowed concessional tariff to the following consumer groups under domestic category in addition to the concessions prevailing as on date.

BPL family having cancer patients or permanently disabled persons as family members due to polio or accidents, provided their connected load is of and below 1000 watts and rate shall be Rs 1.50/unit, for a monthly consumption upto 100 units.

3. For ascertaining whether the family comes in the BPL category, the prevailing stipulations which were relaxed recently, which includes a valid BPL certificate from the concerned local bodies or even an income certificate to the effect that the yearly income of the family is below Rs. 50,000/-(Rupees Fifty thousand only) can be adopted.

4. In the case of families having cancer patient, medical certificate from Government Medical Practitioner or from any reputed institute for cancer treatment shall be insisted for ascertaining the illness of cancer.

5. In the case of permanently disabled beneficiaries, a certificate on permanent disability (benchmark disability in terms Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016) with not less than 40% disability from the medical board shall be insisted.

6. Ration card which includes the cancer patient/ permanently disabled person as a member of the applicant' family or a certificate to that effect from the village officer concerned need be insisted. If the patient is the applicant itself, no such certificate need be insisted.
7. Notice regarding the eligibility criteria of consumers to avail subsidized tariff and details of concessional tariff rates shall be displayed in all section offices.
8. The field officials of Electrical section shall conduct random check to verify the connected load of BPL consumers availing subsidized tariff.
