ORDER

The construction of Edamon–Kochi 400kV Transmission Line passing through 4 districts viz, Ernakulam, Kottayam, Pathanamthitta and Kollam, having 148.3km length and 447 towers has been completed and the line energized on 25.09.2019. The disbursement of compensation for Tower Standing Area(TSA), Line Corridor and Trees/Crops damages are in progress. The Detailed Valuation Statement (DVS) for 408 tower locations (761 holdings) for an amount of Rs. 39.647 crores has been approved by the District Collectors as on 30.09.2019. An amount of Rs. **33.321 crores** has been disbursed to 598 land owners towards TSA compensation by LA Units at 4 districts in which KSEBL has deposited Rs. 5.2 Crore as the share of KSEBL/GOK. The DVS preparation of balance 39 Nos of TSA is under process at various LA units. The Compensation for trees & crops are issued exclusively by PGCIL.

The assessment of corridor compensation is also in progress. The DVS has been approved for 37 spans out of a total of 446 spans for an amount of Rs. 17.616 crores. An amount of Rs. 1.152 crores has already been disbursed from PGCIL fund for 19 land owners towards Line Corridor Compensation at Ernakulam district.

The details of compensation payment as on 30.09.2019 and its share of PGCIL, KSEBL & Government of Kerala is as shown below.

Now, Ernakulam Collector has requested to deposit KSEBL/GoK share of line corridor and also for the disbursement of already approved DVS and ensuing DVS amounts in lieu of line corridor compensation.

As per the G.O read(1) above, Clause(X), "In the first instance, the amount for implementing the special compensation package will be met by KSEB by availing loan. Government share will be granted subsequently".

Hence it is recommended to allocate an amount of Rs. 12 Cr. from KSEBL fund (out of the estimated KSEBL share of Rs. 155 Cr. allocated as per B.O read (4) above, for disbursement of the special compensation package for line corridor part, and the same may be transferred immediately to the Compensation Disbursement Accounts of "Edamon -Kochi Project" through ARU of Transmission Division Pathanamthitta.

Having considered all the aspects as per note read as 7 above , the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 16.10.2019,

Resolved to accord sanction

1. To allocate an amount of Rs. 12 Cr. from KSEB fund (out of the estimated KSEBL share of Rs. 155 Cr. allocated as per B.O No. BO(FTD) No. 1197/2018/ D(T&SO)/T2/Koodamkulam/ 2018-19, dated 07.05.2018) , for disbursement of the special compensation package for line corridor part, and the same shall be transferred immediately to the Compensation Disbursement Accounts of "Edamon-Kochi Project" through ARU of Transmission Division Pathanamthitta.
2. To request the Government to allocate their share on the above for meeting subsequent payments required in this regard.

Orders are issued accordingly.


