ORDER

The Government of India has recently approved Phase II of the FAME India Scheme for adoption of Electric Vehicles with a total budgetary support of Rs. 10000 Crore. The Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises, Government of India, has floated Expression of Interest (EOI) inviting Proposals for availing incentives under Fame India Scheme Phase II for deployment of EV charging infrastructure in select cities in India. Accordingly the last date of Submission of Proposal by eligible public/private entities is fixed as 20th August 2019. The incentives ranges from 50% of the capital cost to 100% capital cost depending on the category, specifically defined in this respect in the EOI.

The installation of charging stations is proposed in any of the cities, considered on the basis of various criteria, such as Million plus cities as per 2011 census, Smart cities as notified by MoHUA, capital city among others. In Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Kochi, Thrissur, Kozhikode, Kannur and Malappuram Municipalities come under million plus cities and Thiruvananthapuram and Kochi come under smart cities category as well

In response to the EOI issued by Department of Heavy Industry Government of India, the proposals for establishing charging stations in 7 Nos of million plus cities were submitted vide note cited above for approval.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 16.8.2019, resolved to accord sanction for submitting detailed proposals as per sample documents in response to the Expression of Interest called for by Department of Heavy Industry Government of India for availing incentives under Fame India Scheme Phase II for the deployment of EV charging infrastructure

Thrissur, Kozhikode, Kannur and Malappuram. Further resolved to authorise, the Chief Engineer (REES) to submit the above proposals to Department of Heavy Industry Government of India.

Orders are issued accordingly.


