ORDER

As part of the State ev Policy, Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd. (KSEBL) has been appointed as the State Nodal Agency for establishing charging infrastructure for electric vehicles (EVs). As articulated in the Central and State policies, there is an urgent need to promote electric mobility. In this regard, KSEBL is committed to take a proactive stance in promoting both public and private investment for charging infrastructure in the State. KSEBL seeks to partner with the central and state governments, PSUs and private investors to make Kerala the first state in India to create an EV charging infrastructure offering full coverage of the state. KSEBL is taking active steps and is willing to partner with potential investors through various business models. KSEBL is also taking other special initiatives towards establishing an EV Charging Infrastructure in the State.

An approach Paper was prepared by the Chief Engineer (REES) as per note read 1st paper above, which describes the approach which KSEBL proposes to adopt to support the EV Policy both for providing power in its role as the state DISCOM as well as for establishing an adequate charging infrastructure as the State Nodal Agency. The objective of the document is to provide a structure for EV charging infrastructure rollout in the State. The matter was placed before FTD in the meeting held on 27.9.2019 as per note read as 2nd paper above

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors resolved to accord approval for the approach paper for formulating the same as a policy documents of KSEB Limited.
