KHEP- Arranging daily food for the staff and contract workers under K.G.Division, Kakkayam-urgent restoration works of Unit#4 – estimate – Sanctioned - Orders issued.

ORDER

The massive land slide occurred at Kakkayam project area on 09-08-2019, had resulted in the total shutdown of the Kuttiyadi Extension Scheme (1x50MW) and Kuttiyadi Additional Extension Scheme (2x50MW) stations and urgent restoration works were planned and executed with the available manpower (staff & contract workers- approximately 75 nos.) in the station for putting back the machines in service.

As the nature of the work demands continuity in execution and considering the non-availability of hotels/ food stalls near the powerhouse premises and for utilising the available manpower for the speedy restoration of the stations, as per B.O read as 1st above sanction was accorded to an estimate amounting to Rs.1,91,250/- for arranging breakfast, lunch and evening tea for 30 days, for the staff and contract workers under K.G.Division, Kakkayam in connection with the urgent restoration works of Unit #4,5 &6.

The Chief engineer (Generation & PED) reported that restoration works of Unit # 6 and Unit # 5 had been completed and the machines were synchronized to grid on 04.09.2019 and 22.09.2019 respectively. The restoration works of Unit # 4 is in progress and it is expected to be completed by 31st October 2019. It was reported that the generator No.6 was put back in service 3 days earlier than the expected date and the food arrangement has contributed a good share towards this achievement. The financial gain for 3 days will come about Rs. 1.8 Crore, whereas the expenditure incurred for the food arrangement was only Rs.1,91,250/-. The generator No.4 is also expected to be put back in service earlier than the scheduled date.

The Chief engineer (Generation & PED) reported that the time required for the complete restoration works could not be ascertained at the time of earlier proposal and sanction was requested for supply of food for only 30 days. Now the period of sanction for the food supply as per the above B.O has been completed. As per the present rate of progress, the restoration works of the remaining generator is expected to be completed by 31.10.2019 and for the speedy completion of those works as well, the food arrangement is to be continued till the completion date.

In the above circumstances, sanction was requested for an estimate amounting to Rs. 2,55,000/- for continuing the supply of food to approx. 75 numbers of staff for 40 days by considering the daily rate of Rs.85/-per day per person. The rates were arrived as per the observed expenses incurred locally.

Having considered the recommendation in the Note read as 3rd above, the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 16-10-2019 resolved to accord sanction to an estimate amounting to Rs. 2,55,000/- (Rupees Two lakh Fifty Five thousand only), for arranging daily meals including breakfast, lunch and evening tea for the staff and contract workers under K.G.Division, Kakkayam in connection with the urgent restoration works of Unit #4.

Orders are issued accordingly.
