ORDER

Electrical Circle, Kollam has to execute UG Cables totaling 19.15 km under IPDS. Of this quantity, 3.696 km is to be laid from Chavara Substation to Neendakara bridge along NH66. The Executive Engineer, PWD (NH Division), Kollam has given a Demand amounting to Rs. 45,85,495/- as Restoration Charges & Licensee fee, for laying 3.696 km of 11kV Cable through Berm, B.T & Concrete Road surfaces.

Out of the Demand, Rs. 10,41,000/- is the Road Restoration charges to be remitted as Bank Guarantee & Rs. 35,44,495/- towards Licensee fee which is to be remitted through Bharat Ghosh Portal. On submission of the payment receipts before the DLCC and subject to their approvals, an Agreement in Stamp paper worth Rs. 3600/- has to be executed. The Cable will be permitted to lay only after completing these formalities under the supervision of NH officials, in compliance with MoRTH guidelines.

As NH authorities has raised a demand note in accordance with MoRTH Guidelines to remit the Restoration charges as Bank Guarantee and Licensee fee (according to the land area used by Public Utilities) through their portal. The Chief Engineer (IT, CR & CAPS) had requested to permit the remittance of demand made by the NH authorities, as per Guidelines issued by MoRTH, as IPDS works cannot be delayed beyond November 2019 to avoid lapse of Grant.

Having considered the request as above and the recommendations of the Director (Distribution & IT), the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 23.10.2019 resolved to accord permission to the Deputy Chief Engineer, Electrical Circle, Kollam for remitting the Road Restoration charges & Licensee fee demanded by the NH Authorities as per the Guidelines issued by MoRTH, and orders issued accordingly, as IPDS works cannot be delayed beyond November 2019.

Orders are issued accordingly.
