ORDER

Board had implemented the programme “Nalekkithiri Oorjam” for improving awareness on energy conservation through schools in coordination with Education Department and Energy Management Centre from 01 August 2011 to 31 May 2012. An estimate amounting to Rs. 70 lakhs for implementing the programme was sanctioned vide B.O read as 3rd paper above. Energy Management Centre had contributed an amount of Rs. 5lakh as their part of share. To compute energy consumption and energy saving of the participants, with the help of ORUMA a software package was developed by the IT wing . An award of Rs 1,00,000/- for best school in the state, Rs 25,000/- for best school in each district and Rs 500/-, Rs.300/-, Rs. 200/- for the best three students in each school was declared vide B.O read above. The evaluation method for selecting the above winners was also specified in the Board Order.

The Deputy Chief Engineer (Corporate Planning) vide his note read above has reported that around 1.23 lakhs students from 2380 schools under Education Department had registered in the programme. He has also reported that the reports were collected from the Deputy Chief Engineers of all Electrical Circles for selecting the winners and that from the energy saving reports received from field, 4MU saving in energy is noted during the programme period by the participants. He has also submitted the draft list of winners at State level and District level for approval of the Board.

Having considered the recommendation of Deputy Chief Engineer (Corporate Planning), the Board hereby approves **St. Joesph HSS, Peruvamthanam in Idukki District** as the best school at state level and the schools listed below as the best schools at District level.
