ORDER

The State of Kerala has witnessed unprecedented heavy South-West monsoon rains this year which has resulted in severe flood calamities. Due to the unexpected intense rains, land slides etc., most places on the river banks got inundated extending over kilometers on either banks of the rivers within no time. The water level had raised up even to the height of two storeys at many places causing fatalities and creating terrible panic situation.

The Govt. vide Order read as 1st paper above has ordered KSEBL and all Govt. departments, Local Self Govt. Institutions, Public Sector undertakings etc. to fix flood marking plates for permanent marking of highest flood line in flood affected Govt. buildings, electric poles etc. indicating the maximum attained water level from the ground level of the structure / building with date of the flood inscribed in it.

The flood marking plate shall be placed at the maximum flood water level that the specific structure / building was impacted. The flood marking plate shall contain the following information

1. Max. water level in Meters as measured from the ground level of the building / structure
2. The date that the flood water reached the maximum water level

The Govt. approved standard template is as follows

The matter as per note read as 3rd paper above was placed before the meeting of the Full Time Directors held on 18-09-2018 and resolved to accord sanction to all Chief Engineers (both Civil & Electrical) to adhere to the directions of the Govt. vide G.O (Rt) No. 483/2018/DMD dated 05-09-2018 and to get the work done through the concerned offices in the flood affected area within a period of three months and to meet the expenditure on account of this work from KSE Board's own fund.

Orders are issued accordingly.


