ORDER

KSEBL, as a part of Ease of Doing Business reforms had reopened the facility for revising connected load for LT domestic consumers based on self declaration vide BO read as 2nd paper above, as announced vide Circular under reference in 2016, till 31st December 2018, where in, the consumers were given the opportunity to regularise their connected load based on self declaration without payment of application fee, testing fee or additional security deposit.

However these consumers will have to pay for network enhancement if the declared new load demands it or if there is change in voltage level and will be liable to pay additional security deposit, if so required during the review at the first quarter of each financial year as envisaged in the Supply Code Regulations.

Following the requests from field officers, the scheme were made applicable to all LT consumers besides domestic, and was extended to 31st January 2019, vide BO read as 3rd paper and further extended upto 31st March 2019, vide BO read as 4th paper above.

In cases where objection exists from any statutory legal authority, the load regularisation in such cases shall be taken up under this Scheme only if the objection has been cleared.

Considering the fact that the Voluntary Disclosure Scheme for regularising the connected load of LT consumers has attracted wide publicity and KSEBL will benefit financially, if the consumers come forward to declare their connected load, the Director (Distribution & IT), suggested that the above scheme be re- opened, vide Note read as 5th paper above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 02.08.2019,

1. Resolved to accord sanction to reopen the facility for revising connected load for all LT consumers based on self declaration announced vide BO read as 4th paper, where in, the consumers were given the opportunity to regularise their connected load based on self declaration without payment of application fee, testing fee or additional security deposit. However these consumers will have to pay for network enhancement if the declared new load demands it or if there is change in voltage level and will be liable to pay additional security deposit, if so required during the review at the first quarter of each financial year as envisaged in the Supply Code Regulations.
2. Further resolved to extend the benefit of the Scheme for the period from **01.08.2019** to **31.10.2019**, subject to the condition that in cases where objection exists from any statutory legal authority, the load regularisation in such cases shall be taken up under this Scheme only if the objection has been cleared.
3. Further resolved to entrust the CPRO/Chief Engineer (IT & CR) to give wide publicity for the above mentioned scheme.

Orders are issued accordingly.
