ORDER

The Chairman and Managing Director while examining the proposal for sanctioning Provisional Pension in respect of Sri. Rajan. K.R, Chief Engineer (Retired), observed that there are series of Disciplinary Action cases against the retired officers which were initiated based on the short assessment bills issued to the consumers. In some cases, the officers are informed about the same post superannuation. Further, in some cases, in which more officers are involved, some get pension and rest did not.

In order to avoid discrimination in sanctioning pension and allied benefits to the retired officers against whom the disciplinary action were initiated based on the Short Assessment Bills issued to consumers/and other issues, the Chairman & Managing Director has directed to Constitute a committee comprising of the Director (Finance), the Director (Generation - Electrical) and the Chief Engineer (HRM) to study the matter in depth and submit recommendation on how to deal in such cases. The Committee shall study the culpability related to Short Assessment Bills, level, dues still pending/the dues recovered and Disciplinary Action initiated against the officers and also the related generic frame work.

Therefore a committee is hereby constituted comprising of the Director (Finance), the Director (Generation - Electrical) and the Chief Engineer (HRM) to study the matter and to submit the report/recommendation, in order to streamline the disbursement of pensionary claims of the retired officers against whom disciplinary action is pending.

Orders are issued accordingly.
