ORDER

The Hon'ble Minister for Electricity emphasized the need for precautions to be taken to prevent accidents. Even though earnest efforts were taken from KSEBL for reducing accidents, accidents are still occurring. Total accidents occurred during the year 2020, 2021 2022 and 2023 were 554, 563, 480 and 401 respectively. During 2023 from Board's installation 401 Nos. of accidents were occurred which include 6 fatal accidents to Board staff and 6 fatal accidents to contract workers.

As per the data available in SMART software, out of 776 Electrical Section Offices there are more than 400 Electrical Section Offices where no accidents were reported during the year 2023. Their work is truly commendable and appreciable, recognizing these zero accident offices pave way to create a safe working culture to the entire KSEBL.

To recognize the contribution of these offices and to appreciate the efforts and meaningful contribution put in by the employees, it is suggested as per note read above to appreciate these offices in Section, Sub Division, and Division levels. Separate appreciation meeting may be arranged in different level to motivate the officers and staff for their earnest effort to make the year 2023 as accident free year, under their jurisdiction.

In order to recognize and appreciate the zero accident Section Offices, it is suggested to award an appreciation certificate and a memento as a token of appreciation to these section offices in a function arranged at Electrical Division level in the presence of concerned Deputy Chief Engineer and Chief Safety Officer. The respective Assistant Executive Engineer may be authorized to submit the nomination of zero accident Section Offices under his jurisdiction to the Division Office for the award.

Also it is suggested to arrange a meeting at Electrical Circle level in order to recognize the Sub Division Offices where there was no accident reported during 2023. Deputy Safety Commissioner and as far as possible the concerned Chief Engineer may attend the function for the felicitation. The Executive Engineers are authorized to nominate the zero accident Sub Division under his jurisdiction to the Circle Offices for the award.

It is also suggested to arrange a meeting at Vidyuthibhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram, in order to recognize the Division Office, if any, where there were no accidents reported during 2023. In this meeting the Chairman and Managing Director / Directors may felicitate and distribute the token of

appreciation to the accident free offices. The Deputy Chief Engineers are authorized to submit the nomination of zero accident Division Office to the Office of the Chief Safety Commissioner in order to recognize the Division Office for the award.

The nominating officers shall personally enquire and confirm that there were no fatal or non fatal accident occurred to any person including Board/Contract Staff or general public or any animals from board installation or from consumer premises during the period from 01.01.2023 to 31.12.2023, before nominating the name of offices for the above said recognition and appreciation.

It is also suggested to display the zero accident awards at a prominent location in the section office so as to motivate officers and staff. Similarly the list can be displayed at prominent location in division, circle, and regional offices.

The appreciation meeting is proposed to conduct in connection with the electrical safety week 2024.

The matter was placed before the Full Time Directors as per the note read above. Having considered the matter in detail the Full Time Directors,

1. Resolved to accord sanction to arrange a meeting to recognize the zero accident Section, Sub Division, and Division Offices and award an appreciation certificate and a memento as a token of appreciation to these offices, in connection with the Electrical Safety Week 2024.
2. Further resolved to authorise Deputy Chief Engineers to arrange the appreciation meeting at Electrical Circle Level, for appreciating the zero accident Electrical Sub Division Office under their jurisdiction.
3. Further resolved to authorise the Executive Engineers to arrange the appreciation meeting at Electrical Division Level, for appreciating the zero accident Electrical Section Office under their jurisdiction.
4. Further resolved to authorise the Public Relation Officer to arrange the appreciation meeting at Vydyuthibhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram, for appreciating the zero accident Electrical Division Office.
5. Further resolved to authorise the concerned officers to display the zero accident awards at a prominent location in the Section Office so as to motivate officers and staff.


