## CIRCULAR

Sub:- Observance of "Constitution Day" in KSEBL on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023  
Instructions issued.

Ref:- Circular No. Cdn4/134/2023/GAD Thiruvananthapuram dated  
18.11.2023.

Government of India has notified 26<sup>th</sup> November as "Constitution Day" to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to pay tribute to the invaluable contribution of Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar and other founding fathers of the Constitution. In connection with the celebrations, it has been decided by the Government of India to read out 'Preamble to the Constitution', in all Government Offices, autonomous bodies/Public Sector Undertakings etc. throughout the country on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023" since 26<sup>th</sup> November 2023 is Sunday.

In the above circumstances, Heads of all KSEB Ltd offices are directed to arrange programmes for observing "Constitution Day" on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023 (Monday) by reading out the 'Preamble to the Constitution' at 11 AM in their offices.

The words imprinted in the 'Preamble to the constitution' is appended herewith as Appendix-I.

Under the above circumstances, as directed by the Chairman & Managing Director, KSEBL, the following instructions are hereby issued.

1. The head of office/institution shall read out the pledge and the same shall be recited by all assembled in the premises of the office/Institution on Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023 at 11 AM.

2. The National Anthem will be sung after taking the pledge.
3. The active participation of all staff members in the pledge taking ceremony in their offices may be ensured by the Heads of Offices, concerned.


The following instructions are issued for conducting the function at Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram.

- a) All the employees working in Vydyuthi Bhavanam Complex Thiruvananthapuram shall assemble on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor near the reception counter for taking the Pledge (Text Appendix). The Chairman & Managing Director will read out the pledge and the same shall be recited by all. The National Anthem will be sung after taking the pledge.
- b) The Executive Engineer, Civil Division, Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram shall arrange the public address system for taking the pledges and for playing the National Anthem.
- c) All Heads of Offices are requested to bring the above instructions to the notice of all employees working under their jurisdiction.
- d) All employees are requested to compulsorily participate in the pledge taking ceremony on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023 (Monday) at 11 AM.

Sub: GAD-Observance of 'Constitution Day' on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023 in all Educational Institutions and Government Departments – Instructions issued - Regarding.

Ref: D.O.No.701/2/2/2022-Cab.III Dated 13.11.2023 from the Cabinet Secretary, Government of India

Government of India has notified 26 November as 'Constitution Day' to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to pay tribute to the invaluable contribution of Babasaheb Dr.Bhimrao Ambedkar and other founding fathers of the Constitution. Every Year as a part of the Celebrations a number of activities aimed at highlighting and reiterating the values and principles enshrined in the Constitution are organised. In connection with the celebrations, Government of India has decided to read out 'Preamble to the Constitution' (as it exists today) in all Government offices, Autonomous bodies, Organisations, Local Self Government Institutions State Legal Services Authority/District Legal Services Authority etc throughout the country on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2023 and to organise competitive activities like Talks/Webinars by eminent citizens on Fundamental Duties etc.

In the above circumstances, all District Collectors, Heads of Departments and Chief Executives of Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies are directed to arrange programmes for observing **Constitution Day** on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023 (Monday) by reading out 'Preamble' to the Constitution at 11:00 a.m in all Government offices, since 26<sup>th</sup> November is Sunday. All educational institutions are also directed to read out the 'Preamble to the Constitution and the fundamental duties as enshrined in Article 51A of the constitution during the assembly session on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023. A provision has also been made on MyGov portal to 'Read the Preamble online and download a Certificate. It is further directed to conduct the Activities such as webinars, debates, speeches, essays and quiz competitions on the constitution of India in connection with the observance of Constitution Day. Universities may have special talks on the constitution.
