ORDER

The Mechanical spinning of Poringalkuthu SHEP (1x24) MW was successfully undertaken on 26.03.2022 and the machine was synchronised to grid on 16.04.2022. The Project was dedicated to the Nation by the Hon'ble Minister of Electricity on 04.05.2022. The Execution of Civil works of Poringalkuthu SHEP was awarded to M/s. GVR-GMW (Joint Venture), Chennai during 2011. The main components of the project were Intake Shaft, Power tunnel, Surge Shaft, Inclined Shaft, Low Pressure Pipe, Horizontal Pressure Shaft, Valve House, Penstock, Power House, and Tail race Channel. During execution, the project had faced several hindrances such as initial delay in handing over of forest land, consecutive floods during 2018 & 2019, lock down due to COVID-19 pandemic, financial constraints of the lead contractor M/s. GVR Infra Projects Ltd due to National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT), etc.

The E&M works were entrusted with M/s. Allonward - SSIPL Consortium and had completed the task successfully though they had to wait until the completion of other work fronts. The team work of dedicated employees of KSEBL as well as the contractors helped spinning and commissioning on the date declared by the Government itself as the progress of work was subjected to judicial review owing to a Public Interest Litigation. The efforts of the concerned employees helped to complete the works smoothly on war footing so that pre-monsoon /monsoon showers of 2022 are well utilized. The hard work and the exemplary performance of the employees involved with the commissioning of the project therefore needs to be acknowledged.

Considering the above, it was recommended and forwarded the following list of employees for awarding Good Service Entry in recognition of their service for the Meritorious Service rendered by them in making the project a reality in the adverse circumstances especially in the commissioning stage.
