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ABSTRACT

Establishment of EV charging stations in 56 locations owned by KSEBL & Government, 26nos under Government of Kerala (GoK) and 30nos under Government of India (GoI), Department of Heavy Industry (DHI),Scheme – MoA to be executed for Government locations and approval for 4 KSEBL locations- Sanction accorded—Orders issued.

ORDER

Administrative Sanction was accorded as per BO read as 6th above, for the installation of 56 EV charging stations (26 under Government of Kerala scheme and 30 under Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) scheme). LoA was issued and agreements were executed with the following contractors for the implementation.

Even though the work was started in some of the locations, various issues are being faced in many locations which need to be addressed to proceed further:

- 1. Request for approval was sent to DHI, Government of India as per letter read as 7th above for change of locations due to non feasibility of the earlier approved location. The approval in case of 11 sites is awaited.
- 2. For 15 government locations, the approval from the concerned authorities has not yet been received. In this context, a meeting was conducted by the Principal Secretary, Transport, GoK.
- 3. Against some of the non feasible locations, alternate KSEBL locations were suggested as detailed below. The Chief Engineer (REES) requested approval to proceed with the work in these locations.

Further, an MoA with the land owners has to be signed in the case of Government locations for handing over of land on right to use basis for setting up of the EV charging station. In this regard an MoA has been framed by Chief Engineer (REES) and scrutinized by the Legal Adviser & Disciplinary Enquiry Officer as well as the Financial Adviser. In the MoA, Clause 2.5 c & d is applicable to CET only.

The Chief Engineer (REES) placed the matter before the Full Time Directors as per note read as 9th above. Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors, in its meeting held on 16.04.2021

- Resolved to approve the MoA to be signed with the land owners in the case of Government locations for handing over of land on 'Right to Use' basis for setting up of EV charging station, attached separately as Annexure in case of Government locations for taking over of land on Right to use basis for setting up of the EV charging stations.
- Further resolved to authorize the Chief Engineer (REES) to enter into the MoA with the authorities concerned.

 Further resolved to approve the alternate KSEBL locations viz. Thiruvalla Substation, Nenmara distribution land, 110kV substation, Kanjikode & 110kV substation, Vadakkenchery as detailed below:

1. BACKGROUND

The Government of Kerala plans to ensure a robust infrastructure for Electric Vehicles by its Electric Vehicle Policy, as a step towards making the State environmentally clean in view of its biodiversity and tourists attraction. By the policy KSEBL is encouraged to set up Charging Stations on its own in Public Private Participation mode and the Government will explore avenues for providing space in public places and Government buildings. The KSEBL has been designated as the Nodal Agency as per the EV Policy of the State issued by Transport (B) Department vide GO(Ms) No.24/2019/Trans dated, Thiruvananthapuram 10-3-2019 for establishing the charging infrastructure and accordingly has established 6 Numbers Fast EVCS in six districts of the State in KSEBL premises and work on another 26 numbers of EVCS across the State is expected to commence shortly in KSEBL's own land and space provided in the Government/Public Sector premises. GO No.22/2020/PD dated 13-2-2020 is issued by the Power Department to hand over Government Land to KSEBL for establishing EV Charging Stations

2. NOW THEREFORE THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ("MoA") WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS:

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "MoA") is entered on this......day of21..................... at Thiruvananthapuram between

Kerala State Electricity Board Ltd., a company incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 having its registered office at Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram, represented by The Chief Engineer (REES), Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram, hereinafter referred to as "KSEBL" (which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the contract or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors, representatives and assignees) of the <u>FIRST PART</u>

(KSEBL and 'The Authorised Person'are hereinafter referred to individually as the "Party" and collectively as "Parties").

Parties herein at the addresses mentioned in Clause 1, or such changed addresses as will be duly notified by the Parties to each other from time to time.

- 2.7. The parties to the agreement hereby agree that there will not be any claim on either side other than the charging facility offered to the second party as per the agreement by the first party
- 2.8. Agreement shall be valid till it is terminated as per the mutual written consent of the parties.
- 2.9. The EVCS to be established is a Public Charging Station hence shall be placed in an appropriate location where the public can have free access 24 X 7.
- 2.10. Any matter which is not stipulated herein as well as any disagreement between parties shall be amicably resolved by the Parties based on mutual discussions within the spirit of this MOA. Any dispute left unresolved by the above procedure shall be referred to a high level committee chaired by both the Chief Engineer(REES) and the head of the institution /Organization or the authorised person of the second party constituted with appropriate number of members recommended by each party.
- 2.11. Considering the status of the parties, a Committee having representation of both the parties chaired be constituted for resolving the issues. Chief Engineer (REES) shall represent KSEBL in the Committee. Head of the Institution/ Organisation or the Authorised person signing the agreement shall be representative of the second party in the committee. Concerned members may be added to the committee in case of a dispute.
