ORDER

The Director, ANERT requested exemption from remittance of electricity charges towards the Public Charging Stations run by them as decided for the 6 charging stations of KSEBL. As part of their Carbon Neutral Governance Project, 3 charging stations have been commissioned with the support of EESL, Government of India on the land owned by DTPC, Tourism and KTDC. They have also informed that installation of 15 public EV charging stations are progressing.

The Executive Committee meeting of ANERT held on 29.12.2020, have decided to approach KSEBL for getting exemption from remittance of electricity charges to ANERT owned charging stations and stations associated with them like EESL until KSEBL continues with the scheme. Hence they have requested to exempt the payment of electricity charges of Public EVCS of ANERT until KSEBL continues with the scheme.

The Chief Engineer(REES) as per Note read as (4) above submitted the consumption details of EV Charging Stations of KSEBL,ANERT and EESL obtained from concerned Electrical Sections and informed that EV Charging Stations owned by ANERT is only one existing at its headquarters and others belong to M/s EESL.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 25.2.2021, resolved to grant exemption from remittance of electricity charges to the EV Charging Station owned by ANERT alone as done in 6 nos of KSEBL owned EV Charging Stations. It was also resolved to assess the total units given free of cost for all charging stations owned by KSEBL as well as ANERT.

Orders are issued accordingly.
