ORDER

KSEBL had provided prior intimation to KSERC as per the letter read 2 above, regarding other business by formation of a JV Company named KFON, in accordance with sections 41 and 51 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The drafts of the JV agreement, Memorandum of Association, Articles of Association which were approved by the government as per order read as 1st were also duly submitted along with the prior intimation. KSERC issued a Suo motu order read 3 above on utilisation of right of way of transmission and distribution network of KSEB Ltd for implementing the KFON project by Government of Kerala and association of KSEB Ltd in the said project with directions to KSEBL has to file a petition for formal approval from the Commission, for sharing the transmission and distribution assets of KSEB Ltd by the Joint Venture Company KFON.

Subsequently, KSEBL intimated KSERC, as per letter read as 4th above, that while prior approval is not legally required as transfer of assets of KSEBL as apprehended by the Commission is not envisaged, KSEBL will be filing the prior intimation in the form of a petition, as desired by the Commission in the Suo motu order dated 27 04 2020.

Accordingly, the Deputy Chief Engineer (Commercial & Planning) with full powers of Chief Engineer placed the matter for approval as per note read 5 above for filing a petition in the matter of KFON. The Chairman & Managing Director granted approval for filing of the petition before KSERC in order to avoid delay and directed

that same may be put up before the Full Time Directors of the Board for ratification. Approval was also granted for remitting an amount of Rs.10,000/- towards petition filing fee and authorizing Deputy Secretary (Administration) to release the cheque.

The Deputy Chief Engineer (Commercial & Planning) with full powers of Chief Engineer further placed the matter before the Full Time Directors as per note read 7 above for ratification of filed the petition before KSERC as per letter read 6 above, for approval for the said petition filed before KSERC.

Having considered the note matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 2.12,2020,

1. Resolved to ratify the action of filing the petition before the Hon'ble Commission in the matter of prior intimation on implementation of KFON in compliance with directions in the Suo motu order dated 27.04.2020, vide Letter No. KSEB/TRAC/C(T)/38/KFON /2020-21/934 dated 19.08.2020.
