ORDER

The practice followed in KSEBL for collecting Electricity Duty on Energy charges from consumers is as per the Schedule of Kerala Electricity Duty Act 1963. As per the Schedule of Kerala Electricity Duty Act 1963, consumers who consume energy generated by themselves are liable to pay duty @ 1.2 paise /unit of energy generated and consumed.

The Government of Kerala had approved the Kerala Solar Energy Policy 2013 as per G.O read above. As per clause 12- d of the Kerala Solar Energy Policy 2013, the Energy generated from the plants under the policy shall be fully exempted from Electricity Duty. Since a Government order cannot supersede an ACT of the Government, suitable amendment has to be made in the Schedule of Kerala Electricity Duty Act,1963 for implementing the direction in the above Government order.

On viewing the above, a lack of clarity is prevailing between the Policy and ACT and suitable amendment need to be applied in the Kerala Electricity Duty Act, 1963 if needed. The Chief Engineer (REES) has brought the above facts before the Full Time Directors as per note read above and requested to take up the matter to the attention of the Government for making suitable amendments to the Kerala Electricity Duty Act, 1963 invocating the content of the Kerala Solar Energy Policy 2013.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 20.11.2020, resolved to request the Government for suitable amendments to the schedule of Kerala Electricity Duty Act, 1963 invocating the content of the Kerala Solar Energy Policy 2013.

Orders are issued accordingly.
