ORDER

The Director (Transmission & System Operation) as per note read as 2nd above intimated that aggressive market operation by exploiting the difference in market rate was being carried out from 31/8/2020 onwards from the office of the Chief Engineer (Transmission-System Operation), Kalamassery. The Director pointed out that for tuning the market operation, a dedicated team working in tandem with the operating crew is essential and that coordination is required at various levels for achieving more efficiency in this market operation , and requested to post one Executive Engineer at the office of the Chief Engineer, Transmission- System Operation, Kalamassery so that the market operation can be made more dynamic and effective with ensuing financial benefits to KSEBL.

As per the request from the LA&DEO, Sri Thobias C. C, Assistant Executive Engineer, Office of the Standing Counsel, Ernakulam, who was promoted and posted as Executive Engineer, PMU, Manjeri, vide order dated 19/6/2020 was allowed to be retained in the office of the Standing Counsel, Ernakulum, for monitoring the cases at the High Court.

The Director (Distribution, IT & HRM) as per note read as 3rd above suggested that the following facts be taken into account for considering redeployment of Executive Engineers to the above offices.

• KSEBL as per BO read as 1st above had constituted a Dyuthi Project Monitoring Division (DPMD) with head quarters at Ernakulum, with staff strength of one

Executive Engineer, one Assistant Executive Engineer and one Sub Engineer, all posted by deployment from other offices, for the effective monitoring of the Dyuthi works. The Executive Engineer, DPMD was to function as the Nodal Officer, Dyuthi and was assigned exclusive responsibility of coordinating the field level activities. Now that the Dyuthi project has overcome the initial hiccups and has been put on track, the place of the Executive Engineer can be spared and the DPMD Division can be disbanded. The two Assistant Executive Engineers presently working at DPMD, and the Sub Engineer, DPMD can be attached to Electrical Circle, Ernakulum, to continue with their present activities of monitoring the Dyuthi works throughout the state.

• The report submitted by the corporate level Restructuring Committee has recommended the disbanding of the three APTS Divisions working in the state and presently stationed at Trivandrum, Ernakulum and Kozhikode. The post of the Executive Engineer, APTS Ernakulum, can therefore be considered for redeployment. The works related to all the Electrical Circles shall be entrusted to the remaining two Executive Engineers, APTS.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 14/10/2020, resolved to accord sanction for the following:

- To post an Executive Engineer at the office of the Chief Engineer Transmission &
 System operation) as Executive Engineer (Market Operations), by shifting the
 post of Executive Engineer from the APTS Central Region, Ernakulam.
- To post an Executive Engineer at the Office of the Standing Counsel, Ernakulam, in place of the Assistant Executive Engineer, based on the recommendation of the LA & DEO, by shifting the post of Executive Engineer from the DPMD, Ernakulam.

Further resolved to accord sanction for the following.

To attach the Assistant Executive Engineers, DPMD, and the Sub Engineer,
 DPMD to Electrical Circle, Ernakulum and direct them to continue with their present activities of monitoring the Dyuthi works throughout the state.

- To attach the APTS District Units coming under the seven Districts of Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Ernakulam and Idukki to APTS, Southern Regional unit Thiruvananthapuram, and the district units coming under Thrissur, Malappuram, Palakkad, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Kannur and Kasargod to APTS, Northern Regional Unit, Kozhikode.
- 3. To direct the Chief Engineer, HRM to suitably redeploy the Senior Assistant and the Fair Copy Assistant now working at the APTS, Central Region, Ernakulam.

Orders are issued accordingly.
