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ABSTRACT

ORDER

As part of TransGrid 2.0 project, 66 kV Pallivasal-Aluva line was upgraded to 220/110 kV MCMV line in the RoW of old 66 kV Aluva-Pallivasal line and during the upgradation work, the conductors of these lines were routed over the house of Smt. Sulekha Beevi and Sri C.M Dileep. The complainant had approached different forums with complaints and KSEBL explained the details of line construction to the Additional District Magistrate and other statutory authorities. The Additional District magistrate , Ernakulam has directed to disburse the eligible compensation for the additional RoW. The additional RoW used is 1.552 Are and as per the letter vide read as (1) above, 15 % of the fair value of land used has to be paid by KSEBL as RoW compensation. Hence , for the upgradation of this line Rs 52,817 has been paid as compensation to Sri. Dileep C.M.

Later the complainant approached the Hon'ble Minister for Electricity for additional compensation as he is facing grave financial situation. Moreover, he is having a differently abled child and he has to look after his old parents also .The Hon'ble Minister for Electricity directed to consider the case of the complainant for reasonable compensation similar to Edamon-Kochi line compensation package. As per the G.O read as (3) above for Edamon-Kochi line special compensation package, clause No.19(1), the compensation package is meant exclusively for the construction of 400 kV transmission line in the Edamon- Kochi sector is approved, in recognition of the peculiar facts and circumstances involved in the issue, as a special case and subject to the condition that the same will not be applicable in any other case on any ground or quoted as a precedent.

Hence a special package is recommended by the Director (T&SO) similar to the Edamon-Kochi special compensation package as follows.

A land area of 216.79 m² (5.357 cents) of the complainant already in the existing RoW is falling in the new line corridor also. Hence as per the Cl (9) and 19 (ii) (C) of the GO(Ms.)No.29/2015/PD dt: Thiruvananthapuram 30/7/2015 (Edamon –Kochi revised special compensation package) the exgratia compensation amount calculated for the corridor comes to Rs. 1,96,736/-

Also additional ex-gratia compensation as per the clause 19(I)(vii) of the GO(Ms.)No.29/2015/PD dt: Thiruvananthapuram 30/7/2015 (Edamon –Kochi revised special compensation package) for having house under the line comes to Rs.100000/-Hence total corridor compensation calculated amounts to Rs.2,96,736/-

Of this Rs 52,817/- has already been paid as compensation to Sri. Dileep C.M and Smt. Sulekha Beevi and the balance amount comes to Rs 2,43,919 (Rupees Two lakh Forty three thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen only)

The Director (Transmission &System Operation) as per note read as (4) above elaborated the details of corridor compensation applicable and to consider the poor financial situation of the complainant on humanitarian basis as a special package and will not be applicable to any other /general cases and placed the proposal before the Full Time Directors. The Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 04.11.2020 had detailed discussion in the matter and “**Resolved** to accord sanction for paying the additional corridor compensation amount of Rs.2,43,919/- to Sri.Dileep C.M. and Sulekha Beevi,Chingathil House, Perumbavoor as part of upgradation of 66kV Pallivasal-Aluva Line to 220/110 kV MCMV line as a special relief by taking a sympathetic view in the light of the peculiar situation of the family.”


