### ORDER

KSEBL is in the process of setting up of around 250 Charging Stations across Kerala under various Government Schemes. As per GO read as 1<sup>st</sup> above, setting up of charging stations in the following sites are in progress and expected to be completed within a short span of time.

Subsequent to this, price bids of two tenders read as 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> above for setting up of 26 and 30 EV Charging Stations respectively were opened and the work orders are expected to be awarded in due time. Most of the charging station locations among these are in KSEBL owned land and some are Government land, which will be given to KSEBL on right to use basis.

It is proposed to avail service connection for the charging stations in the name of Engineer in Charge of the concerned locations. Accordingly the Chief Engineer (REES) as per note read as 4<sup>th</sup> above requested sanction to exempt Application Fee, Estimated Cost of Service Connection (ECSC) and Security Deposit Charges to avail service connection for EV Charging Stations set up by KSEBL.

The Director (T&SO) in the note read 4<sup>th</sup> above directed to put up the proposal before Full Time Directors. Accordingly the matter was placed before Full Time Directors as per note as 5<sup>th</sup> above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 25.09.2020 resolved to accord sanction for the following:

1. To authorize the Engineer in Charge to avail Service Connection of EV Charging Stations.
2. To exempt Application Fee, Estimated Cost of Service Connection (ECSC) and Security Deposit (CD) for availing the Service Connection
