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ABSTRACT

Construction of 33kV Substation, Pinnakkanadu – purchase of land by negotiation through DLPC – sanctioned- orders issued.

ORDER

In order to meet the power demand of Pinnakkanadu and surrounding areas like Chettuthodu & Parathodu, a 33kV Substation is proposed to be constructed at Pinnakkanadu. Presently the above areas are fed from the fag end of 11kV feeders of 110kV Substations Mundakkayam & Kanjirappally and 33kV Substation Paika. It is reported that the voltage regulations of these 11kV feeders are above the permissible limit. The load flow study recommended a 33kV Substation at Pinnakkanadu with 2x5MVA 33/11kV transformer. The proposed Substation will improve the voltage regulation and increase the voltage profile at 110kV Substations Mundakkayam and Kanjirappally.

The Administrative Sanction was accorded as per B.O. read as (1) above for the construction of 33kV Substation at Pinnakkanadu and its associated lines in Kottayam District for an estimate amounting to Rs. 14.63 Crore. In the estimate an amount of Rs 97.25 Lakhs was provided for the purchase of land.

The Chief Engineer, Transmission South has reported that after several enquiries, three sites were identified for the construction of the Substation and the consent of the land owners also received. The comparative study of the sites are conducted. Considering the terrain, accessibility, shape & extent of the land, proximity to load centre & 110kV Substation, financial and technical parameters, the Chief Engineer, Transmission South has recommended the purchase of land of 35 cents belonging to Sri. Paulson V.C., Vellukunnel (H) Chemmalamattom in Sy. No.282/9 of Kondoor Village, Meenachil Taluk, Kottayam District for the construction of 33kV Substation, Pinnakkanadu.

The matter was placed before the Full Time Directors as per note read as 3rd above. Having

Resolved to accord sanction for the purchase of 35 Cents of land in Re survey No. 282/9 of Kondoor Village, Meenachil Taluk, Kottayam District belonging to Sri. Paulson V.C., Vellukunnel (H) Chemmalamattom through negotiated purchase by the District Level Purchase Committee (DLPC) for the construction of 33kV Substation Pinnakkanadu.

Orders are issued accordingly.
