#### **ORDER**

KSEBL as per B.O. read 1 above accorded sanction to retain the contract period of hired vehicles as 1 year and to allow an extension of contract for a further period of 1 year at the same rate, terms and conditions, as per the existing general conditions of contract.

As per B.O. read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above, it was resolved to accord sanction to adopt the revised Government rates for hiring vehicles in KSEB Ltd also with the condition that the hiring of vehicles shall be arranged for a period of one year by the concerned Deputy Chief Engineers/Project Managers after inviting competitive open tender with wide publicity as per norms.

The Deputy Chief Engineer, Transmission Circle, Thrissur as per letter read as  $3^d$  above requested clarification on whether the extension of contract period of 1 year at the same rate, terms and conditions is admissible to vehicles tendered after 19/03/2019 as Transmission Circle, Thrissur is having vehicles running at both above and below the rates specified in B.O. read  $2^{nd}$  above. Other requests have also been received from the field offices in the matter.

The matter was placed before Full Time Directors as per note read as 4<sup>th</sup> above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 30/05/2020, resolved to accord sanction that the existing vehicle contracts can be extended for a further period of one year, if the existing vehicle contractor is willing to supply the vehicle at the same terms and conditions, provided the rates are at or below the rates sanctioned as per B.O. (FTD) No.262/2019 (D(D&IT)/D/AEC/Veh/129/2019) dated 19/03/2019.
