ORDER

KSEBL, as a part of Ease of Doing Business reforms had extended the facility for revising connected load for all LT consumers based on self declaration as per BO read as 1st above, wherein LT consumers under all categories were given the opportunity to regularise their connected load from 01.08.2019 to 31.10.2019. This was further extended up to 31.12.2019 as per BO read as 2nd above and thereafter until 30th June 2020 as per BO read as 3rd above.

For regularising the connected load, the applicant need not pay application fee, testing fee or additional security deposit. However these consumers will have to pay for network enhancement if the declared new load demands it or if there is change in voltage level and will be liable to pay additional security deposit, if so required during the review at the first quarter of each financial year as envisaged in the Supply Code Regulations. In cases where objection exists from any statutory legal authority, the load regularisation in such cases shall be taken up under this Scheme only if the objection has been cleared.

Based on the fact that the scheme has attracted wide publicity and KSEBL will benefit financially, if the consumers come forward to declare their connected load, and also aid in planning for meeting the demand of the consumers and considering the fact that due to lockdown conditions and social distancing norms still in place due to the threat of the pandemic COVID 19, the Director (Distribution, IT& HRM) suggested as per Note read as 4th above, that the scheme period may be extended further by six months.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in its meeting held on 25/06/2020,

- Resolved to accord sanction to extend the facility for revising connected load for all categories of LT consumers based on self declaration announced vide BO dated 03.08.2019 up to 31.12.2020 subject to the condition that in cases where objection exists from any statutory legal authority, the load regularisation, in such cases shall be taken up under this Scheme only if the objection has been cleared.
- 2. Further resolved to entrust the CPRO/Chief Engineer (IT & CR) to give wide publicity for the above mentioned scheme.

Orders are issued accordingly.
