Special Scheme to provide electric connection free of cost to the Un-Electrified Anganwadis in the State – Sanctioned - Orders issued.

### ORDER

The Director, Women & Child Development Department as per letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> above, has sought assistance in providing electric connection to around 2256 un-electrified Anganwadis in the State as part of a special drive in connection with the 100 days programme of the Government. A district wise list of such un-electrified Anganwadis was also identified so as to achieve the electrification of Anganwadis by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021. It was also informed that the "Electrification of Anganwadis" may be carried out with funds available by including the same in any of the existing projects of KSEBL and to expedite the process for payments made from the Panchayath/ Women & Child Welfare Department.

For effecting connections in case of Anganwadis, proof of ownership is not required for the period for which the Anganwadis function in the said building; connection can be effected based on an undertaking from the concerned District Social Justice Officer or any other officer duly authorized by him, as per BO read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above.

As per Regulation (32)of the Supply Code 2014, KSEBL as a licensee is bound to recover from the owner or lawful occupier of any premises requiring supply, the expenditure reasonably incurred by the licensee for providing from the distributing main, any electric line or electrical plant required exclusively for the purpose of giving that supply, provided that exemption may be granted to any person requiring connection from the payment of expenditure if the State Government directs the licensee to provide new electric connection to any category of consumers and pays in advance to the licensee, the expenditure at the rates in the Cost Data approved by the Commission.

In the meeting held on 30.06.2021, chaired by the Hon'ble Ministers, the reports collected from the field offices were reviewed and the following decisions were approved.

- It was directed that a scheme shall be announced wherein wired buildings functioning as Anganwadis, shall be effected free of cost, using Board's fund, with a maximum of inserting one post, as expeditiously as possible.
- In case of Anganwadis requiring more than one post, the entire cost for effecting such connections shall be executed by using funds from the respective local body/ agencies.
- In places where it is not feasible to draw electric line considering its topography and other factors, DDGs are to be setup for providing connection under the chairmanship of ANERT.
- Unwired Anganwadis shall approach the concerned Section offices, after completion of wiring & obtaining requisite approvals/consent for drawing electric line, so that maximum connections can be effected as part of a special drive in connection with the 100 days programme of the Government.

The matter was placed before the Full time Directors as per Note read as 6<sup>th</sup> above for a decision.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full time Directors in the meeting dated 12.07.2021,

1. Resolved to accord sanction to convey the following decisions in the meeting dated 30.06.2021, to the field officers for compliance.

- a) Electric connection shall be effected free of cost, using Board's fund, with a maximum of one post in wired buildings functioning as Anganwadis, as expeditiously as possible. In case of rented buildings, the connection availed under this scheme shall be disconnected upon relocation/ shifting of Anganwadis.
- b) In case of Anganwadis requiring more than one post, the entire cost for effecting such connections shall be executed by using fund from the respective local body/ other agencies.
- c) Unwired Anganwadis shall approach the concerned Section offices, not later than 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021, after completion of wiring & obtaining requisite approvals/ consent for drawing electric line, so that maximum connections can be effected as part of a special drive in connection with the 100 days programme of the Government.
- d) In places where it is not feasible to draw electric line considering its topography and other factors, DDGs are to be setup for providing connection through ANERT.

- e) To collect the application fee & minimum Cash Deposit of Rs 200/- towards Security for effecting new connection to Anganwadis under this Scheme.
- f) To meet the ECSC charges for providing connection to Anganwadis, with a maximum of one post from Board's Fund.

2. Further resolved to authorize the Chief Engineer (IT, CR & CAPs) for making appropriate changes in the OrumaNET software for incorporating the above modifications.
3. Further resolved to intimate to the Director, Women & Child Development Department, to ensure that the District Social Justice Officer/Anganwadis submits the application for service connection so that maximum number of connections can be effected under this Special Scheme.

Orders are issued accordingly.
