ORDER

Sri. Aadeeshwaramoorthy, in his representation read as 1st above, stated that, he had applied for a service connection for agricultural purpose in his land with survey No. 177/1/5. After verifying the details, KSEBL directed him to pay Rs.69,112/-. In the petition submitted to the Hon'ble Minister for Electricity it is stated that, he is financially weak to pay the entire amount together and requests permission to remit the estimated amount in instalments. Since instalments are not generally given for Estimated Cost of Service Connections, a report was called for from the field offices.

The Deputy Chief Engineer, Electrical Circle Palakkad, as per the letter read as 2nd above, reported that Sri. Aadeeswaramoorthy, Anuppur Kovil Kalam, Ozhalapathy, has applied for a 3-phase service connection for agricultural purposes with all the required documents. He has also produced certificate from the agricultural officer stating that he belongs to the category of Small Farmer and holds 1.44 hectares of agricultural land. The Assistant Engineer, Electrical Section Velanthavalam, inspected the site and an estimate amount of Rs. 69112/- for the construction of a 75 m new 3-phase line and for the conversion of a 120 m single phase line to a 3-phase line was prepared. The Deputy Chief Engineer recommended granting instalments for the Estimated Cost of Service Connection (ECSC) for effecting the agricultural service connection to Sri.Aadeeswaramoorthy.

The matter was placed before the Full Time Directors as per note read as 3rd above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors, in the meeting held on 06.02.2023, resolved to authorize the Deputy Chief Engineer, Electrical Circle Palakkad,
