Withdrawal of fuel surcharge for the consumption of electricity with effect from 01.10.2010 –orders issued by the Commission - compliance- Orders issued

ORDER

KSERC vide the order read as 1st paper above has approved an amount of Rs 190.00 crore as fuel surcharge for the period from April to September-2009 and also ordered to realize the same from all consumers @ 25 paise per unit (except domestic consumers with monthly consumption less than or equal to 20 units and connected load less than or equal to 500W) for the consumption from 1st April-2010 for a period of six months or till the amount of Rs 190.00 crore is fully recovered. Board vide the order read as 2nd paper above has issued necessary directions to all functional units and field offices to collect the fuel surcharge @ 25 paise per unit for the consumption from 1st April-2010. KSERC vide the order dated 20.09.2010 had reviewed the matter and permitted the Board to collect the surcharge @ 25paise per unit till 30th September 2010.

2. Chief Engineer (Commercial & Tariff) vide the note read as 2nd paper above had reported that, as per the KSERC order dated 05-04-2010 and 20-09-2010, Board is allowed to collect the fuel surcharge for the consumption only up to 30-09-2010 and requested approval to issue necessary instructions to all the field offices, Special Officer (Revenue) and Director (IT & SPIO) to not to levy fuel surcharge for the energy consumption from 1st October-2010. Chief Engineer has also reported that, in the case of monthly billed consumers (LT, HT & EHT), the surcharge shall not be levied for the energy consumption from 1st October-2010 and this can be easily implemented. But, in the case of bi-monthly billed consumers, the demand raised from 1st October-2010 to 29th November-2010 shall consists of part of the energy consumed during August and September-2010 and this part of energy consumption shall be levied with fuel surcharge @ 25 paise per unit and this is to be segregated from the billed energy from 1st October-2010 to 29th November-2010 on prorata basis.. In order to simplify the process, a pro-rata multiplication factor is arrived and given as Annexure to this order.

The billing procedure is given below.

Fuel surcharge to be collected from 1st Oct-2010 to 29th Nov-2010

- (1) The energy to be billed with fuel surcharge @ 25 paise per unit, $E1 =$ Billed consumption as on billing date, $E \times$ the multiplication factor (f) as on billing date.
- (2) Fuel surcharge, $FS = E1 \times 0.25$

Having considered the recommendation of the Chief Engineer (Commercial & Tariff), Board here by orders:

- (1) not to levy fuel surcharge for the energy consumption from 1st October-2010.
- (2) To levy the fuel surcharge @ 25 paise per unit from the bi-monthly billed consumers for the part of the energy consumption during the period from 2nd August-2010 and 30th September-2010.
- (3) to adopt the multiplication factor as given in the table annexed to this Board order to arrive the pro-rata energy consumption from the billed energy for the period from 1st October-2010 to 29th November-2010.
- (4) The Director (IT) & SPIO, Special Officer (Revenue) and all the field offices shall take further necessary action in this regard.


