The Government of India has received financing from the World Bank (Loan No: 9181-IN) towards the cost of Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project Phase II (DRIP II) and it is intended that part of funds to cover eligible payments under the contracts for the work "DRIP II IHEP Pressure washing on downstream side of Kulamavu dam" detailed below. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016, And Revised August 2018 "Procurement Regulations" Bidders are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in Clause 3 of the Instructions to Bidders to qualify for the award of the contract. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 3.14 and 3.15 of the "Procurement Regulations" setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

- 3. The bidding document is available online on e-Government Procurement (e-GP) website <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u> for a non-refundable fee specified in the table below. This fee shall be paid through online portal of Government Procurement (e-GP). Bidders will be required to register on the website, which is free of cost. The bidders would be responsible for ensuring that any addenda available on the website is also downloaded and incorporated. - 4. For submission of the bid, the bidder is required to have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the Certifying Authorities authorized by Government of India for issuing DSC. Aspiring bidders who have not obtained the user ID and password for participating in e procurement in this Project, may obtain the same from the website: www.etenders.kerala.gov.in. after remitting applicable processing fee. A non-refundable fee of Rs. 5900/- (inclusive of GST) is required to be paid (to be submitted along with other documents listed in paragraph 5 below) before the bid submission deadline. The mode of payment shall be in the form of cash through online payment mode of Government (e-GP) website www.etenders.kerala.gov.in.
- 5. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of the amount (specified in Table 1 above in any one of the forms as specified in the bidding document. The Bid submission fee and Bid security can be paid in the following manner through e-Payment facility provided by the e-Procurement system. No exemption for remitting bid security is allowed to any bidder. EMD exemption option allowed in the e-tender portal is only to facilitate uploading scanned copy of Bank Guarantee; if Bid security is submitted as BG. Bid security will have to be in any one of the forms as specified in the bidding document and shall have to be valid for 45 days beyond the validity of the bid. Bids should be valid for 90 days after the deadline date specified for bid submission. The Bid submission fee and Bid security can be paid in the following manner also through e-Payment facility provided by the e-Procurement system. State Bank of India Multi Option Payment System (SBI MOPS Gateway): Bidders are required to avail Internet Banking Facility in any of specified banks for making tender remittances in e Procurement System. During the online bid submission process, bidder shall select SBI MOPS option and submit the page, to view the Terms and Conditions page. On further submitting the same, the e-Procurement system will re-direct the bidder to MOPS Gateway, where two options namely SBI and Other Banks will be shown. Here, Bidder may proceed as per below: a) SBI Account Holders shall click SBI option with its Net Banking Facility, where bidder can enter their internet banking credentials and transfer the Tender Fee and Bid Security amount. b) Other Bank Account Holders may click Other Banks option to view the bank selection page. Here, bidders can select from any of the 55 Banks to proceed with its Net Banking Facility, for remitting tender payments. Procedure for submission of bid security is described in Para 5 of ITB.
- 6. The Bid must be submitted online on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in. Last date of submission of bid, date of opening of bid etc. is detailed in Table 1. Record of bid opening will be electronically shared with bidders. Any bid or modifications to bid (including discount) received outside e-procurement system will not be considered. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue. The electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bid.
- 7. The bidders are required to submit (a) original demand drafts towards the cost of bid document and registration on e-procurement website (if not previously registered); and (b) original bid security in approved form at the address given below before the bid submission deadline, either by registered post/speed post/courier or by hand, failing which such bids will be declared non-responsive and will not be opened.

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8. The Employer shall not be held liable for any delays due to system failure beyond its control. Even though the system will attempt to notify the bidders of any bid updates. The Employer shall not be liable for any information not received by the bidder. It is the bidders' responsibility to verify the website for the latest information related to this bid.
